As well, the exhibition has received critical acclaim in Hungary's arts editorials. The works return to Montreal to open on March 13, 2010, at Maison de la Culture NDG. The exhibition is then scheduled to travel to New Brunswick to the City of Saint John Art Centre to be part of that city's 250th anniversary celebrations.

This unprecedented project showcases the work of over 40 Canadian-Hungarian artists, highlighting the important role that these artists have played within Canada's multicultural tapestry.
